Noise and dust are back in the church!

Their presence are due to the ongoing work this time. The marble pulpit and angels that are being installed have just been delivered.

The project 'Adoring & Preaching the Eternal Truth' is well on its way!

Recent interview with Canon Lebocq, Prior of Sacred Heart Church:

"When we moved here last year it was raining both in the church and residence, the heating was broken and everything was empty. All statues, Stations of the Cross and benches had been sold or removed, including the main altar and tabernacle.

The vocation of our community is to give praise to God through a beautiful liturgy, by the celebration of Holy Mass according to the traditional rite in Latin, to adore Our Lord present in the Blessed Sacrament, to sing Divine Office; but also to preach and teach the Catholic Faith in its integrity.

That is why both liturgical items are linked and necessary for this church: we must first pray and adore Jesus like angels but the divine truth must also be explained and understood by the sermons."

occasion to renew our profound gratitude to God and to live in a spirit of thanksgiving. This church had been closed, it seemed to be dead but it is definitely coming back to life!


This Holy Mass is offered for all benefactors of Sacred Heart Church, living and deceased, and as always for your intentions."


Holy Week began with a community pilgrimage to Croagh Patrick.



The well-loved and iconic Catholic church of St Walburge, Preston has been given a promise of a sustainable future and a new lease-of-life following announcement Sunday 6th April 2014 by the Bishop of Lancaster, the Right Rev Michael G Campbell OSA.

Bishop Michael Campbell and Monsignor Gilles Wach, Prior General of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest, together with Parish Priest Father Simon Hawksworth, have agreed to establish a foundation of the Institute at the Church of St Walburge, Preston next autumn.
