RECENT PILGRIMAGE FOR VOCATIONS IN LISIEUX

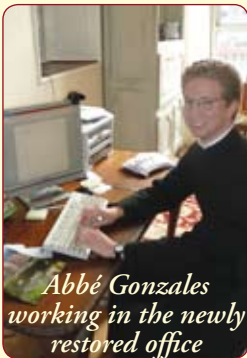


Last 16th through 19th October Canon Coggeshall and abbe Ben McEvilly hosted 15 Irish pilgrims on the occasion of the Institute of Christ the King's annual pilgrimage for vocations to Lisieux, France. Events included a Solemn High Mass sung by Monsignor Michael Schmitz in the stunning Lisieux Cathedral, a solemn procession to the basilica dedicated to St. Therese of the Little Flower and a visit to the

Carmel where the saint's body is on display for veneration. That Friday, the pilgrims also visited several holy sites in the ancient city of Paris, starting with the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal on the Rue du Bac. From there they saw the Seminary for foreign Missions, Sacred Heart Basilica and finally Notre Dame Cathedral. The weekend was very busy, but the graces received are certainly invaluable!
