SAINT FRANCIS DE SALES AND SUMMER RECREATION



As we enter into the long days of summer our reflection upon God’s Divine Glory should continue.

The cessation of school classes and the beginning of family holidays do not have to necessarily be interpreted as a sort of vacation from God or, somehow incompatible with Him. In fact, healthy recreation forms an important part of the Salesian spirituality practiced by the Institute’s members.

Saint Francis de Sales, one of our primary patrons says that “From time to time one must recreate and relax in mind and body...It is actually a defect to be so strict, austere and unsociable that one permits neither oneself nor others any recreation time...To take the air, to go for a stroll, to enjoy a friendly chat, to play music, or sing or hunt...are such honest diversions that the only thing needed to utilize them well is simple prudence, which gives to all things their rank, time, place and measure.” It would be the excessive attachment to recreation that we are to avoid during summertime. The same saint says, “If you spend too much time on games they are no longer recreations but occupations.” Let us therefore enjoy these months of recreation, never forgetting He who makes them possible for our spiritual and bodily good.
