Tuesday, 31st October to Saturday, 4th November 2017

Official Pilgrimage of the Institute of Christ the King to Fatima for the Centenary of the apparitions of Our Lady at Fatima led by His Eminence, Raymond Leo Cardinal Burke.

TUESDAY, 31ST OCTOBER: DUBLIN-LISBON-FATIMA

- Meeting at the Dublin International Airport for our direct flight to Lisbon. (Dublin 6:30 pm - Lisbon 9:20 pm).
- Arrival at the Lisbon International Airport and welcome by our local guide. Visit to Lisbon to see the Sé Cathedral and its treasury. This fortified Romanesque structure was rebuilt after the Reconquista of Lisbon and the expulsion of the Moors. Visit to the Church of St. Anthony, built over the birthplace of the beloved St. Anthony of Padua. Discover the old quarter of Alfama, one of the most picturesque areas of Lisbon with its winding alleys, cul-de-sacs, colourful houses and endless staircases.
- Transfer to Fatima. Arrival at Inn. (Lunch on your own. Dinner and evening spent at Fatima).

WEDNESDAY, 1ST NOVEMBER: FATIMA-COIMBRA-FATIMA

- Holy Mass in the morning followed by an excursion to Coimbra, home of the first university in Portugal, and one of the oldest in the world. The old town is situated on a hill known as the Alcaçova, reached by a tangle of narrow and interweaving alleyways split by staircases bearing odd names.
- Visit to the Carmel of St. Teresa, where Sister Lucia lived until her death in 2005.
- Visit to the University and its baroque chapel dedicated to St. Michael, and then on to the Church of the Holy Cross, built in the pure Portuguese Manueline style. Finally, a visit to the Convent Church of St Clare to venerate the relics of St. Elisabeth of Portugal, wife of King Denis who reigned during the 12th century and is particularly invoked to obtain peace. She is commemorated by the universal Church the 8th July.
- Lunch. Dinner and evening spent at Fatima.

THURSDAY, 2ND NOVEMBER: FATIMA-BATALHA-FATIMA

- Morning visit to Batalha Abbey, a world heritage site. The Monastery of Our Lady of Victory was built to commemorate the victory of the Portuguese over the Castilians at the Battle of Aljubarrota in 1385. It was the Portuguese monarchy's primary building project over the next two centuries, transitioning from gothic to Manueline architecture. The royal cloister is a masterpiece and perfect illustration of this Portuguese architectural style.
- In the afternoon, return to Fatima for the official opening of the pilgrimage of the Institute of Christ the King. Holy Mass in the Rosary Basilica.
- Lunch. Dinner and evening spent at Fatima.

FRIDAY, 3RD NOVEMBER: FATIMA

- Pilgrims will follow the schedule organised by the Institute of Christ the King.
- Pontifical Mass sung by His Eminence, Raymond Leo Cardinal Burke.
- Lunch. Dinner and evening spent at Fatima.

SATURDAY, 4TH NOVEMBER: FATIMA-LISBON-DUBLIN

- Transfer to Lisbon for the flight to Dublin (Lisbon 10:30 - Dublin 1:30 pm).

The schedule for this pilgrimage to Fatima is subject to change due to modifications in flight times and opening hours of sites. In the case of modifications or changes for these reasons, all will possibly be done to accommodate pilgrims.
